

BlackBerry Internet Service™ Lite

- Built upon the same platform as BlackBerry® Internet Service
- Offers a subset of the features available with the BlackBerry Internet Service



BlackBerry Internet Service™ Lite provides the following features:

- Push email messaging
 - Add up to 10 existing email addresses
 - View, manage, and respond to email messages from the BlackBerry smartphone
 - Add an optional BlackBerry email address, which has the following format:

<username>@<serviceprovider>.blackberry.net

- View HTML Email*
- Download attachments in their Native Format*





BlackBerry Internet Service™ Lite upgrade or downgrade

When upgrading from BlackBerry® mail and messaging to BlackBerry® Internet Service, the following features are retained:

- Added email accounts
- BlackBerry email address
- Instant messaging applications



BlackBerry Internet Service™ Lite upgrade or downgrade

To upgrade from BlackBerry Internet Service™ Lite to BlackBerry Internet Service, request the upgrade through your wireless service provider. When upgrading, the following occurs:

- BlackBerry Browser is wirelessly installed on the BlackBerry smartphone allowing Internet browsing
- Service books are sent to the BlackBerry smartphone



BlackBerry Internet Service™ Lite upgrade or downgrade

To downgrade from BlackBerry Internet Service[™] Lite to BlackBerry® Mail, request the downgrade through your wireless service provider. When downgrading, the following occurs:

- Automatic deletion of added email accounts
- Automatic deletion of all instant messaging applications
