Formula for calculating performance scores of circles is as follows:

- a) For Score 1 & Score 5= (NET connection Addition/Total NET Connection at start of Year)* ARPU* Weightage
- **b)** For Score 2 = ((Connection provided within 7 days/ Total connection booked)/100) * Weightage
- c) For Score 6 = ((Connection provided within 15 days/ Total connection booked)/100) * Weightage
- **d)** For Score 3 & 7 = (Benchmark for fault rate #/ Fault rate of circle)* Weightage
- **e)** For Score 4 & 8 = (Fault repairing rate by next working day of circle/ 90)* Weightage
- 3. Total Score of a circle will be sum of score 1 to 8. These scores will be published on Intranet portal on monthly basis.
- 4. Winner on zonal basis shall be decided by the total score for three months period of the financial year i.e. Jan 2014 to March 2014.

5. To maintain the uniformity all data related to performance will be taken from IPTC Pune.
